MEP PERMIT APPLICATION PACKET

Mechanical, Electrical & Plumbing (MEP) Permits are needed for projects that involve mechanical, electrical and/or plumbing work <u>only</u>. If a project includes anything "more" – like a finished basement that includes plumbing work, or solar panels that include electrical work – a Building Permit is needed.

Note... a permit is not needed if you are repairing/replacing (1) an existing HVAC system, (2) an existing electrical switch, or (3) an existing sink, commode, tub, shower or other plumbing fixture that does not require altering a drain or venting device.

MEP PERMIT APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE RETURNED TO THE APPLICANT.

- 1. **MEP PERMIT APPLICATION**. Complete all applicable sections of the MEP Permit Application, and sign and date the application.
- 2. **PLANS**. Plans must include detailed information and all relevant specifications for the proposed work. All plans must include a floor plan drawing of the project area. Three sets of plans must be submitted. In addition, all plumbing plans for work at commercial properties must be signed and sealed by a licensed architect or professional engineer.
- 3. **BUILDING AND IMPERVIOUS COVERAGE CALCULATIONS**. There is a limit to how much impervious surface can be added to any property in the Township. But for most MEP projects the work to be done doesn't create additional building or impervious coverage, in which case there's no need to complete this form. But if the project includes new building or impervious surfaces like installing a concrete pad for an emergency generator you'll need to calculate how much building and impervious coverage exists today, and how much will exist after the project is completed. Some of the information you'll need to complete this calculation like the property size, house dimensions, and tax parcel number can be found at lancasterpa.devnetwedge.com.
- 4. **CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE**. If your project is being completed by a contractor, the contractor must provide a certificate of insurance that names the Township as a certificate holder and additional insured, to be listed as "East Cocalico Township, 100 Hill Road, Denver PA 17517." The contractor must also complete the Pennsylvania Workers Compensation Insurance Coverage Information form.
- 5. HOME IMPROVEMENT CONTRACTOR VERIFICATION. If your project is at a residential property and the work is being completed by a contractor, State Law requires the contractor to register as a home improvement contractor with the Office of the Pennsylvania Attorney General. Ask your contractor to provide his/her current license, or visit hicsearch.attorneygeneral.gov to download and print the contractor's license status (it must be valid), and submit this information to the Township.
- 6. **PERMIT FEE**. The permit fee must be paid at the time the permit is approved for pick-up. Fees vary by project type. Visit ect.town to view the current Fee Schedule.
