**MOSQUITOES NEED STANDING WATER TO SURVIVE...**

- MOSQUITO LARVAE, LIKE THOSE BELOW, CAN BECOME ADULTS IN ONLY 5-7 DAYS!!!
- ORGANIC, PONDING WATER ON REED BEDS & SLUDGE BEDS IS IDEAL MOSQUITO HABITAT!



**ELIMINATE STANDING WATER, OR KEEP IT MOVING!**



**FLUSH THE CORNERS OF CHLORINE CONTACT TANKS WEEKLY!**

**DUMP THE SCUM PIPES & SKIMMERS FREQUENTLY!**



**FLUSH OR AERATE TANKS WEEKLY!**

**MOSQUITOES WILL BREED IN MOST ARTIFICIAL CONTAINERS THAT HOLD WATER...**

- MAINTAIN REGULAR DUMPSTER & TRASH COLLECTIONS.
- COVER OR DISPOSE OF TIRES & ARTIFICIAL CONTAINERS.
- CLEAN GUTTERS ANNUALLY.

**AVOID THROWING GRASS CLIPPINGS IN CATCH BASINS.**



**MOSQUITOES SEEK OUT ORGANIC WATER!**



# ***Eliminate*** MOSQUITOES!

## REGULAR MAINTENANCE

- **AERATE OR FLUSH** offline tanks on a weekly basis.
- **DUMP** scum pipes often.
- **FLUSH** corners of chlorine contact tanks. ~ MOSQUITOES THRIVE THERE!
- **MAINTAIN** regular dumpster & trash collections.
- **COVER OR DISPOSE** of tires & artificial containers.
- **KEEP OUT!** ~ No grass clippings in catch basins!
- **EMPTY** buckets, cans, & dippers daily.
- **CLEAN** gutters annually.
- **TRIM** grass, shrubs, & weeds.
- ALSO... **FIND, SEAL, & FLUSH** hidden crypts & obsolete pipes.
