On the Agenda...

The Board of Supervisors meets on May 2 and May 16. The May 16 agenda includes a public hearing to consider a grant application to the Lancaster County Community Development Block Program. The Township is seeking funds to improve the parking lot and trail at the East Church Street Skate Park.

On May 8 the Zoning Hearing Board is expected to announce a decision on a request to install a communications tower at Wikes Trail and Violet Drive.

At its May 20 meeting the Planning Commission will consider a plan for a small office building and mini-storage facility at North Reading Road and Jason Avenue.

Complete agendas are posted at ect.town at least twenty four hours before each meeting.

A proposed plan for the Crossings at Cocalico subdivision at West Swartzville Road. This development includes 93 single family homes and townhomes, and 90 apartments. The site plan may be viewed on the list of active subdivisions and land development that is always posted to ect.town, and the full plan set (*all 69 sheets!*) may be viewed at the Township Building during normal business hours. The plan will be reviewed at a Planning Commission meeting this summer.
